I understand that this procedure requires single synthetic eyelashes to be glued to my own natural eyelashes. I understand that it is my responsibility to keep my eyes closed and be still during the entire procedure, until my eyelash technician addresses me to open my eyes. I understand that some risks of this procedure may be but not limited to eye redness and irritation. The fumes from the adhesive may cause my eyes to tear up if I open my eyes.

I agree to disclose any allergies that I may have to latex, surgical tapes, cyanoacrylate, Vaseline, *etc.* I understand that I am required to follow the Single-strand eyelash extension Care Sheet (attached hereto) in order to maintain the life of these extensions.

I agree that by reading and signing this consent form, I release Denise Rodrigues and the Lash Den from any claims or damages of any nature. I agree that I read and fully understand this entire consent form. I am of sound mind and fully capable of executing this waiver for myself.

Eyelash extensions are not for everyone. This is a high-maintenance beauty treatment that requires gentle care for the lashes to remain in good condition and be long-lasting. Once the lashes are attached, you must not rub or pull on them. You must not wear any mascara or use eyelash curlers. Please read and understand all the information listed below and sign the form prior to having this service done. _____[initial]

What are eyelash extensions?

Eyelash extensions are individual synthetic eyelashes. They are attached one-by-one to each individual natural eyelash—not to the skin. This service is beauty enhancing and eliminates the need to wear mascara. It is a meticulous service which requires the skill and precision of a certified lash technician. Once the eyelash extensions are applied, they are so natural looking that it is difficult to tell that you have extensions on. Size availability ranges from short to long which will be decided and agreed upon with your certified eyelash technician. _____ [initial]

How long will my single-strand eyelash extensions last if I follow the proper care instructions?

In some cases, eyelash extensions can last up to 6-8 weeks. However, it is common to get a touch up after about 2-4 weeks. Like all hair, there are 3 phases to the eyelash growth cycle,

- Anagen—the ‘active growth phase’. Only 40% of the upper eyelashes are in active growth at any one time. This phase lasts for 30-45 days;
- Catagen—the ‘transition phase’ when the eyelash stops growing and the follicle shrinks. This lasts 2-3 weeks; and
- Telogen—this is the ‘resting phase’ and can last over 100 days before the eyelashes fall out.

There are some lashes in each phase at all times, therefore, some will be lost within a couple of weeks as part of the natural cycle. _____[initial]

How much do they cost?

The cost for our eyelash application starts at \$125.00 per full set and goes up depending on the desired look. Removal of the lashes cost \$20.00 for 20 minutes of work—therefore, if you are putting on a new set, there will be a \$20.00 charge for removal plus the cost of your new set. Please do not attempt to remove any lashes on your own. We recommend that you seek professional assistance from your eyelash technician. We will not be held liable for any damage that you may cause by trying to remove your eyelash extensions on your own. _____[initial]



Do the eyelash extensions damage my natural eyelashes?

No. Each lash extension is adhered to one single natural lash, which will grow out naturally as your own lash matures. The eyelash adhesive is formulated to create a solid bond, specifically for human lashes. The adhesive dries very soft on lashes, allowing the lashes to stay flexible and bouncy just like your own lashes. _____[initial]

What you should do before your eyelash extension appointment?

Remove all eye makeup and clean your lashes with mild oil-free cleanser. Do not use oil-based makeup removers to clean your lashes prior to the application. Do not put on any mascara. We do not want to spend time cleaning your lashes—we'd rather spend time working on perfecting your lashes. If you are a contact-lens wearer, please remove your contact lenses and wear glasses to your appointment—or bring a lens case and remove your contacts upon arrival. Plan to set aside approximately 2 to 2.5 hours for your appointment. _____[initial]

Please review and follow our recommendations on the attached Care Sheet.

For the first 48 hours, please:

1. do not allow the lashes to get wet;
2. avoid steam—so no spas, saunas, or cooking in a steamy kitchen. Steam will affect the glue stopping it from bonding properly;
3. do not swim.
4. do not rub, perm or tint lashes before or after lash extension application
5. do not rub your eyes or lashes when washing your face--clean around the eyes with a wash cloth or cotton pad
6. do not pull your lash extensions—as you're likely to pull out your own natural lash with it
7. do not put mascara on your lash extensions
8. do not try to remove the extensions on your own
9. do not cut your extensions—you risk cutting your natural lashes _____[initial]

What happens if a lash should loosen or become dislodged?

Do not pull on the lash. Please contact your technician to make an appointment to have them removed or replaced, in order to avoid damage to your natural lash. As your natural lashes fall out due to the growth cycle, you will need refills when your new lashes grow in. At first, you may find that you need a refill every 2 weeks. As you become accustomed to the extensions and with a little practice in maintaining the lashes, the time between refills may be extended to 3 weeks _____[initial]
